and Wednesday, August 5 8 a. m. to 12:00 Noon.

Closing time for entries is the same as stated in general rules. Any articles brought later cannot compete for prizes but may be placed on exhibit by permission of superintendent. Exhibits should be selected for type, uniformity, quality and maturity. Allowance will be made in judging for immaturity of this season's growth. Do not select the large overgrown specimens, but choose a medium size that will show adaptation to York County and suitability for market purposes. Farm Products entries must be York County products only and must be growth of this year unless otherwise stated. A participant is only allowed one entry per class. A champion will be named in each division and a department champion will be named in Farm Products and Fruits and Vegetables. The department champions will receive a \$5 extra premium.

Division 117 - Youth Basket Display

Youth ages 8 or younger may exhibit in this class. Exhibit consists of between 3 and 8 different kinds of vegetables to be displayed in a basket provided at the time of entry. Youth should bring a variety of vegetables for display at time of entry and will be given time to arrange their own display at the time of entry. No parents will be allowed in the display area.
